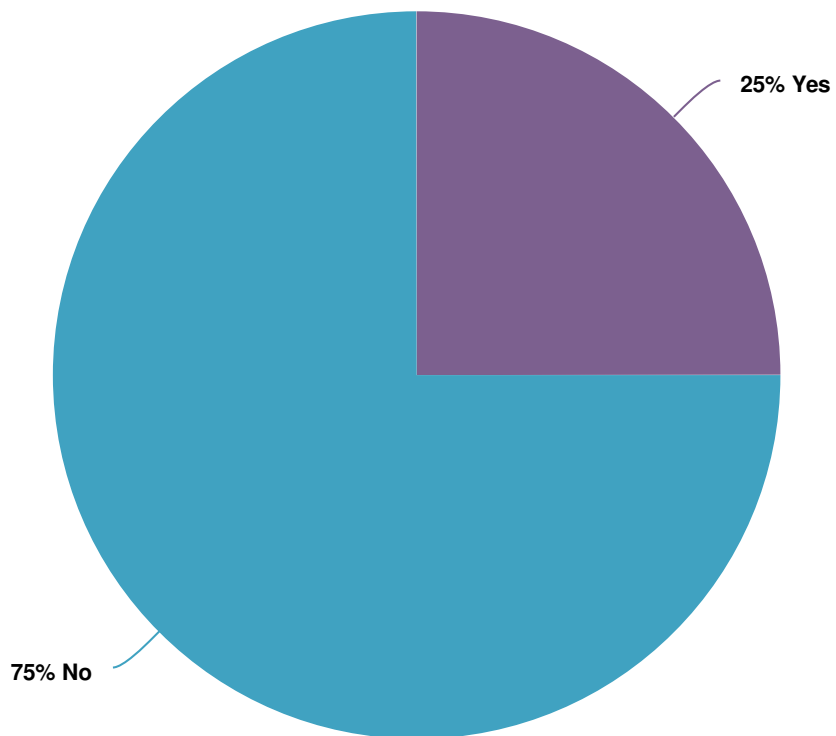

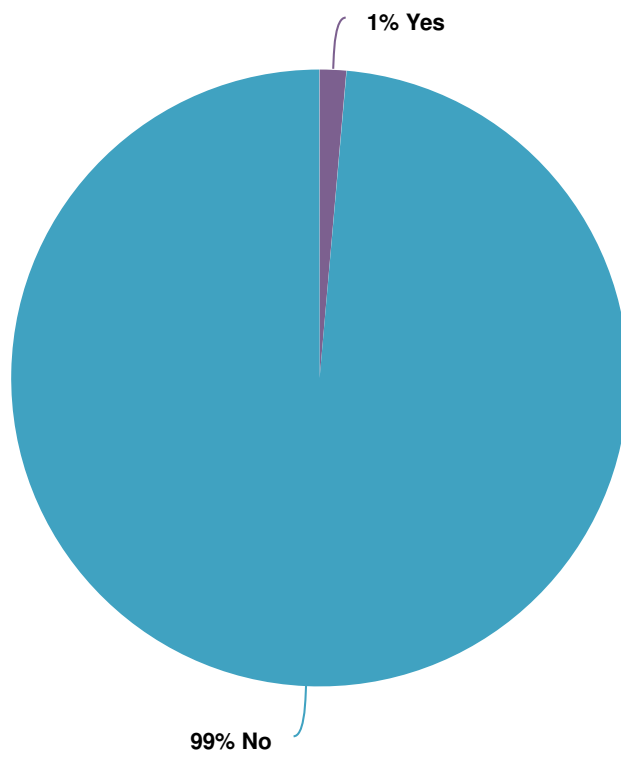

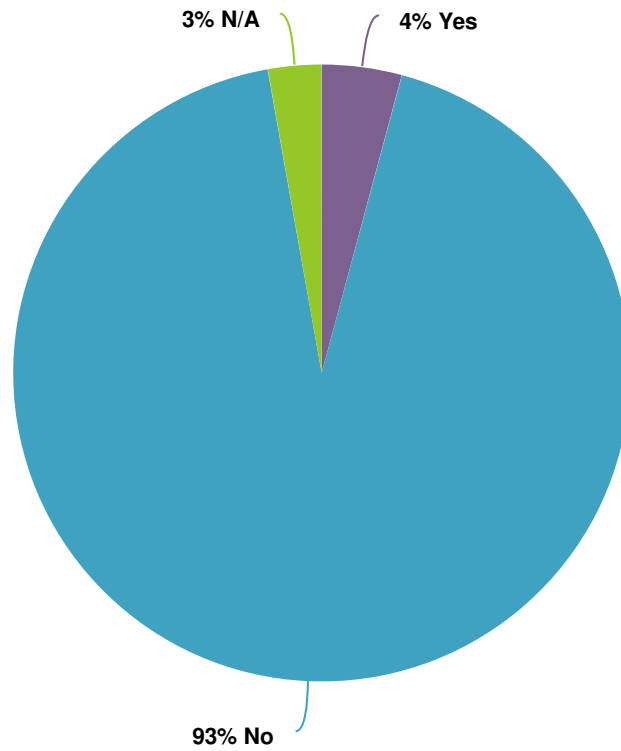
21. Are you a current smoker ?

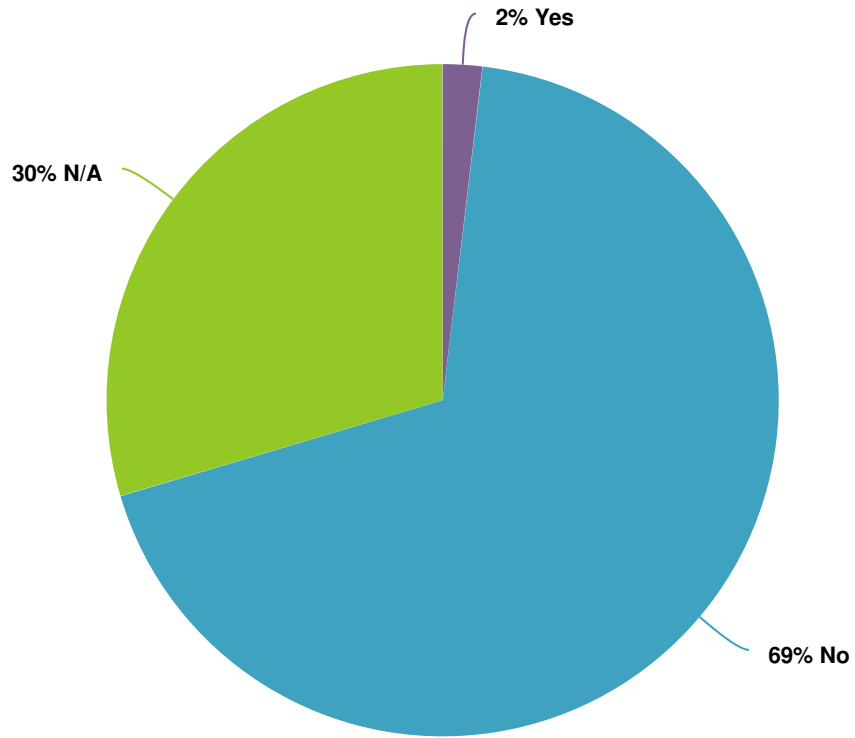
22. Are you exposed to secondhand smoke?
